

Ordinance # 17-1

STATE OF WISCONSIN

Town of Osceola

Fond du Lac County

The Town Board of the Town of Osceola, Fond du lac County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.13, Wis. Stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the regulation of stopping, standing, or parking of vehicles on town highways in the town as follows.

- A. The stopping or parking of vehicles on the following town highways in the Town of Osceola is subject to following restrictions and limitations:
 - 1) Kettle Moraine Lane from the intersection of Cty Rd F south and west to the intersection of Birchwood Drive
 - 2) All of Nonn's Court
 - 3) All of Second Street from the lake south to the end.

- B. The Town chairperson or his or her designate shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above described highways on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

- C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above mentioned highways in violation of the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted stopping, standing or parking restrictions or limitations. Any violation shall be subject to a forfeiture of \$200.

- D. Any vehicle that is found to be an obstruction of the above mentioned highway may at the discretion of the town designee be towed away at the owner's expense.

- E. The Traffic Officer that enforces the above ordinance shall be the current Town Supervisors, Town Chairman, and anyone designated by the Town Board.
